Who can attend?

The Texins Flying Club Ground School is open everyone. It is not restricted to just employees of TI and its affiliated companies. You don't need to become a member of the Texins Flying Club in order to take our ground school. Everyone is welcome!

What does it cost?

Tuition is \$60 for club members taking the GS for the first time, and costs \$190 for non-members. (If you join the Club on registration night, the GS tuition is free.). You will also need to purchase a set of materials that cost about \$100. The FAA charges

\$150 to administer the written examination.

When are classes?

All class sessions will be held at the Texins Activity Center on the TI North Campus on Tuesday and Thursday evenings from 6:30 PM until 9:30 PM.

When can I actually begin flying?

Flight instruction can take place concurrent with ground school, however only TFC members can fly TFC aircraft. Foreign nationals must also meet additional TSA requirements.
